ITINERARY

DAY 1: Gateway City - Billings, Montana

Board your private motorcoach and head to your hotel in Billings, Montana. Relax and enjoy the amenities before departing for dinner at Montana's Rib and Chop House later this evening. **D**

DAY 2: Billings - Whitefish

It's "Rise n' Shine!" Following breakfast, depart Billings for Whitefish, Montana-- the gateway to Glacier National Park. **CB, D**

DAY 3: Whitefish - West Glacier - Lethbridge

Following breakfast your tour departs Whitefish for West Glacier. Later, your coach arrives at Lake McDonald Lodge for a highlighted departure on a vintage Jammer tour bus. Travel along the "Going-To-The-Sun-Road" with spectacular views, a reminder of what it was like to travel around Glacier National Park with style and grace in the 1930's. Enjoy lunch on your own at St. Mary's Lodge & Resort then continue to Lethbridge. **B, D**

DAY 4: Lethbridge - Ft. MacLeod - Banff

Following breakfast, depart Lethbridge for Ft. MacLeod and visit Head-Smashed-In Buffalo Jump Interpretive Center. Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1981, it has been used continuously by aboriginal peoples of the plains for more than 5,500 years. Its bragging rights are well-earned as it's the largest, oldest and best preserved of all bison jumps in the world. The jump represents an exceptionally ingenious hunting technique used by Plains Indians up to 10,000 years ago. Travel northwest to the Canadian Rockies to the spectacular town-site of Banff. **CB, D**

DAY 5: Banff - National Parks

Depart Banff and enjoy a full day of guided sightseeing by driver highlighting Banff National Park, Yoho National Park, The Continental Divide, Lake Louise, Valley of the Ten Peaks and Moraine Lake. Later this evening return to Banff. **CB**



DAY 6: Peyto Lake - Columbia Icefields Parkway - Athabasca Glacier - Jasper

This morning stop to see the turquoise waters of Peyto Lake, named in honor of the famous mountain trader, "Wild Bill" Peyto. Then travel north along the scenic Columbia Icefields Parkway. It winds between snow-domed peaks and immense, hanging glaciers. Moose, bear, deer, bighorn sheep and mountain goats flourish throughout this area. Visit the greatest mass of ice outside the Arctic Circle, the Columbia Icefields & the mighty Athabasca Glacier. Enjoy an exciting ice explorer ride across the glacier. Melt waters from this ice mass, known as the Columbia Icefields, flow into the Pacific, the Atlantic and the Arctic Oceans. **CB, D**

DAY 7: Jasper - VIA Rail

Enjoy a Jasper city tour followed by free time to explore. Later today, board VIA Rail's "The Canadian" whose beautifully restored rail cars, originally built in the 1950's, meet modern standards while retaining their classic style. You are now on your way to the Rockies! Enjoy the sights from the comfort of your seat or wander into the domed observation lounge. Be on the lookout for wildlife! Tonight sleep to the rhythm of the rails. **B**

DAY 8: VIA Rail - Vancouver

Upon arrival in Vancouver for a one-night stay, enjoy a comprehensive tour of this wonderful city. Today's sights will include 1,000-acre Stanley Park, the beautiful Sunken Gardens of Queen Elizabeth Park, Gastown, Lion's Gate Bridge and Chinatown-- second in size to San Francisco's. This afternoon, enjoy some free time to explore. **D**

DAY 9: Vancouver - Seattle

Following breakfast, depart Vancouver by deluxe motorcoach for Seattle, Washington. Enjoy a guided tour of Seattle including Salem Ladders at Ballard Locks. A trip to Seattle would not be complete without a visit to the Space Needle. Built in 1962, it served as the symbol of that year's World's Fair. It has since become the symbol of Seattle and one of the most recognizable structures in the world. Enjoy a special farewell dinner this evening at the Sky City Restaurant atop the Space Needle. **B, D**

DAY 10: Seattle - Gateway City
