



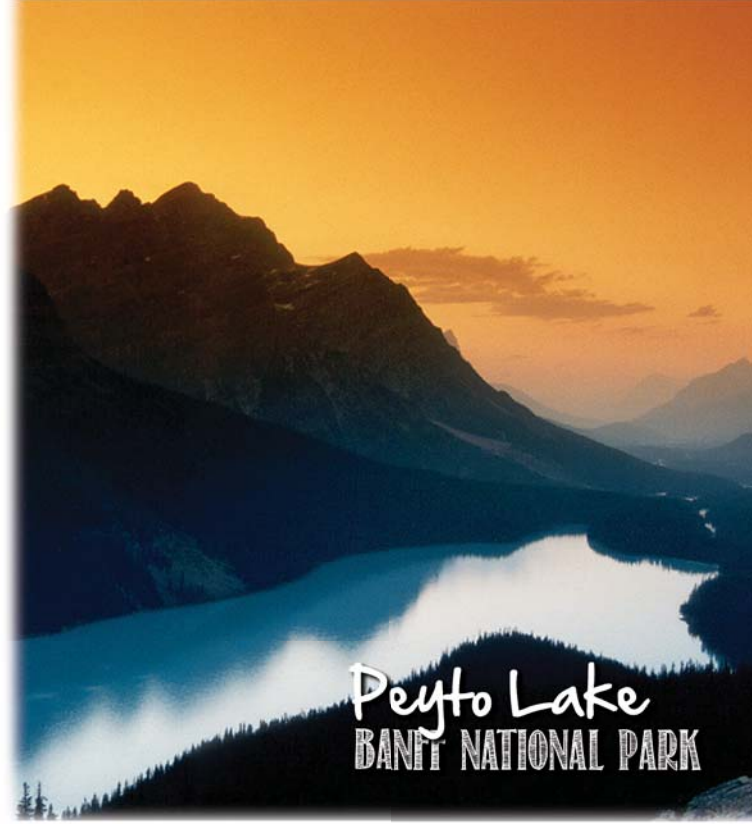
Discover ALBERTA & THE CANADIAN ROCKIES By RAIL

ITINERARY

Day 1: Milwaukee, Wisconsin or Chicago, Illinois - Overnight Amtrak

In Milwaukee (or Chicago), board one of Amtrak's most popular trains, the Empire Builder, for an exciting journey to East Glacier, Montana. Sit back and relax in your luxury coach seats or your private sleeper as you travel through Wisconsin (or Illinois), Minnesota and North Dakota into Montana.

Day 2: Amtrak Journey - Shelby, Montana

Today the Empire Builder train takes you through North Dakota and across the great state of Montana. Late this afternoon your train arrives at Shelby, Montana. Board a private motorcoach and embark on a wonderful vacation through Montana and then into British Columbia and Alberta. Join your traveling companions for a "Welcome to the Tour" dinner at one of Montana's local Supper Clubs. Spend the night in Shelby.

Day 3: Glacier National Park - Going-to-the-Sun Highway - Whitefish, Montana

After breakfast, travel to Glacier National Park in Montana. In 1932, the U.S. and Canadian governments voted to designate the Waterton Lakes and Glacier Parks as Waterton Glacier International Peace Park, the world's first and only National Park shared by two countries, and in 1995 they were named a World Heritage Site. Enter East Glacier and travel the incredible Going-to-the-Sun Highway through the park; it's one of the most scenic roads in North America. Take a guided tour aboard one of the historic Glacier Jammers... the only way to experience Glacier National Park. The refurbished red buses (called Jammers locally) provide tours around and through the park today as they did in the 1930's. After crossing Logan Pass, the tour ends in West Glacier. Travel a short distance to Whitefish, Montana, for a one-night stay. Join your fellow travelers this evening for a delicious dinner.

Day 4: Whitefish - Banff, Alberta

This morning, board your private coach and begin an exciting trek into the heart of the Canadian Rockies. Cross the Canadian/US border (passport required) as you make your way into the Rockies. Around every bend of the road you experience the scenic beauty that has made this territory a destination favorite for travelers from around the world. Later today, arrive at the resort town of Banff for a three-night stay.

Day 5: Columbia Icefields Parkway - Athabasca Glacier - Peyto Lake

Enjoy an included breakfast this morning, then travel north along the scenic Columbia Icefields Parkway located in Jasper National Park. It winds between snow-domed peaks and immense, hanging glaciers. Moose, bear, deer, bighorn sheep and mountain goats all inhabit this area. Stop and visit the greatest mass of ice outside the Arctic Circle, the Columbia Icefields. Enjoy an exciting "Ice Explorer" ride across the Athabasca Glacier. This afternoon you may choose to embark on an unforgettable helicopter excursion over the icefields and the Canadian Rockies (optional). En route back to Banff, stop to see the turquoise waters of Peyto Lake, named in honor of the famous mountain trader, "Wild Bill" Peyto. Afterwards, visit the Jewel of the Rockies, the spectacular Lake Louise. Take a moment to enjoy this breathtaking glacial lake and the magnificent Chateau Lake Louise Hotel; this is one of the many highlights of our great adventure. Tonight, enjoy dinner at Lake Louise before returning to Banff for a relaxing evening.

Day 6: Banff - Waterton Lakes National Park - East Glacier, Montana

This morning after an included breakfast, head south to Waterton Lakes National Park where Alberta's Native tribes lived for thousands of years. The park is a model of environmental cooperation; girdled by a chain of deep glacial lakes, there is an unbelievable variety of plants and wildlife. Cross the border back into the U.S. as you journey to East Glacier, Montana for your final overnight stay at the historic Glacier Park Lodge. A special farewell dinner is included.

Day 7: East Glacier - Amtrak Journey to Milwaukee or Chicago

After breakfast, board Amtrak's Empire Builder for the journey back to Milwaukee (or Chicago). Recline in your comfortable coach seat or in your optional selected sleeper and enjoy the ride.

Day 8: Arrive Milwaukee or Chicago

This afternoon your train arrives in Milwaukee (or Chicago) where you end your amazing trip with fond memories of discovering Alberta & the Canadian Rockies!
