Welcome to the Great Land of Alaska! Our land vacation begins in Anchorage and continues to Denali National Park. We will explore the back country of Denali on an eight-hour Tundra Wildlife Search. Here's where we really experience Alaska... we will travel on the Denali Highway from Denali for 138 miles; this is one of the most scenic and less travel roads in Alaska. We then connect with the Richardson Highway into Valdez. From Valdez we will board a private charter boat for an eight-hour glacier and wildlife cruise and experience the glaciers up-close & personal as we make our way to Cordova, Alaska. From Cordova, we will board a small ship and cruise the Prince William Sound as we observe calving glaciers, search for Marine life and learn about this incredible Sound. Upon arrival in Whittier, Alaska, we will re-board our private motorcoach and travel back to Anchorage for the final night of our unforgettable Alaskan adventure.

Itinerary

DAY 1: Gateway City - Anchorage, Alaska

Fly to Anchorage, Alaska. Upon arrival, we will board our exclusive sightseeing motorcoach for an orientation of Anchorage. After checking into our hotel, we will enjoy a "Welcome-to-the-Tour" dinner this evening. **D**

DAY 2: Anchorage - Talkeetna - Denali Nat'l Park

Following breakfast, enjoy a tour of Anchorage sights to include the historic downtown district. Later travel by private coach as we continue north alongside the stunning Chugach Mountain Range to the mountain-climbing community of Talkeetna. Take in the feel of this quaint community on a brief walking tour led by your tour director. In the late afternoon, check into one of Denali's resorts for a two-night stay. **B**

DAY 3: Denali National Park Sights

Following breakfast, enjoy an early morning narrated eight-hour Tundra Wildlife Search featuring the scenic beauty and wildlife living in Denali National Park. The park is over 6 million acres and includes spectacular Mt. McKinley at 20,320 feet. During our tour, a box lunch will be served in the midst of the natural beauty. Later this afternoon you may opt for various optional activities. How about a float trip, white water rafting, jet boat or a visit to Iditarod champion, Jeff King's Husky Homestead Dog Kennels or join in on the fun at the Denali Dinner Theater, a rollicking musical comedy that will have you clapping and singing. **B, BL**

DAY 4: Denali Highway to Valdez

This morning we will travel by coach through some of Alaska's most spectacular country... The Denali Highway. The Denali Highway is an often overlooked treasure taking the traveler back to Alaska's rich prehistoric past, it's colorful gold rush history and the awesome wilderness that remains throughout much of the state. No longer the primary route to Denali National Park, the highway is lightly traveled on the 133 miles between Denali Park & the Richardson Highway. View breathtaking vistas and snow-capped mountain ranges through a region that is a virtually untapped remote wilderness. This highway less traveled offers wildlife viewing opportunities that will surpass the imagination. The Denali highway will bring us onto the Richardson Highway... The Richardson was Alaska's first highway. It began as a pack trail in the late 1800's with branches to Eagle and Fairbanks. The 364 miles of this paved highway constitute one of the state's most scenic routes. Near Valdez, the highway winds along the turbulent Lowe River in Keystone Canyon. The sheer canyon walls contain countless waterfalls and interesting rock formations. Overnight in Valdez, a town locals refer to as "Little Switzerland". Our hotel overlooks the local fishing fleet and is sure to be a memorable experience. **B, PL, D**



DAY 5: Valdez - Glacier Wildlife Cruise - Cordova Alaska

This morning we will board Stan Stephens Glacier and Wildlife Cruises for an unforgettable and PRIVATE eight hour cruise, including lunch, on the majestic Prince William Sound en route to Cordova, Alaska, for a two-night stay. Upon arrival, we will check into the Orca Adventure Lodge. The lodge provides family-style dining; there are no phones or TV at the lodge and free use of bikes, kayaks, etc. are available for guests. A true Alaskan experience awaits you in Cordova, located on the shores of the Prince William Sound. **B, L, D**

DAY 6: Cordova at leisure - Child's Glacier - BBQ dinner - Alaska park ranger

This morning is set aside for you to enjoy this magnificent area of Alaska. Many options are available to you including floatplane excursions, fishing, rafting, biking. This afternoon we will travel to Child's Glacier for a BBQ dinner and bonfire at the base of this incredible Glacier. TBI has included an Alaskan Park Ranger to join us and educate your guests on the importance of this eco-system. This Glacier is a stunning 300+ ft. high. Look for this glacier to calve before your eyes. It is possibly one of the most active glaciers in Alaska. Later return to Cordova for the night. **B, D**

DAY 7: Small ship cruising of the Prince William Sound to Whittier - Anchorage

This morning board an exclusive the Stan Stephens Glacier & Wildlife Cruise for a seven-hour adventure, including lunch, on Prince William Sound enroute to Whittier, Alaska. Travel the shorelines of the Sound, see Columbia Glacier and watch for sea-life playing in their natural habitat. Upon arrival in Whittier, re-board your private coach as you travel back to Anchorage for the final overnight at the Inlet Tower Hotel (or similar).

DAY 8: Anchorage - Gateway City

This morning is free to relax and prepare for your return flight home. Transfers to Anchorage Airport will be provided for all guests.
