DAY 2: Colorado Springs

After a hearty breakfast, we depart for an incredible journey aboard the Pikes Peak Cog Railway. This morning's adventure will take us to the observation area of Pikes Peak at 14,100 feet high where we will take an exciting narrow gauge train ride to the summit of this world-famous attraction. Then it is on to the beautiful Garden of the Gods to enjoy lunch on our own. Here we will see some of our country's most unique Red Rock formations. Afterwards, we will stop at the U.S. Air Force Academy to explore the Visitor Center and the Cadet Chapel. This evening we will enjoy a show at the Iron Springs Melodrama Dinner Theater. **B, D**

DAY 3: Wolf Creek Pass - Durango

After breakfast, we will depart Colorado Springs for a very scenic day of travel. Our first stop will be the Firefighter's Memorial where a bronze life-sized statue commemorating fallen firefighters stands on pillars of Colorado rose granite. The memorial is engraved with more than 100 names of Colorado's lost firefighters and forever marks the ultimate sacrifice these men and women made. Our journey continues as we make our way through Wolf Creek Pass, one of Colorado's most spectacular routes. En route, we will stop to have a boxed lunch amidst nature's beauty! Later, we will arrive in the historic, western town of Durango, Colorado for a two-night stay. **B, L**

DAY 1: Gateway City - Denver - Colorado Springs

This morning we travel to Colorado, known as the "Rocky Mountain State". Upon arrival in Denver, we will have a guided tour of this cosmopolitan "Mile High





DAY 4: Durango

Today we will relive the history of this area with the sights and sounds of yesteryear! We will enjoy an exciting journey aboard the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad. We will experience the adventure of traveling by a coal-fired, steam-powered locomotive on the tracks that miners, cowboys and settlers used over a century ago. The D & S Railroad winds through breathtaking canyons in the remote two million acre wilderness of the San Juan National Forest. It's an unforgettable one-way ride into the western town of Silverton. Here we will have an opportunity to browse shops and have lunch on our own before returning by motorcoach back to Durango. **B, D**

DAY 5: Taos - Santa Fe

This morning we leave Colorado and head for the "Land of Enchantment"--New Mexico. We will follow the Santa Fe Trail through the Rio Grande & San Juan National Forests and cross the Continental Divide. We will stop in the charming artist colony of Taos, the birthplace of the popular, southwest art movement and former home of Kit Carson. Later, we will arrive in Santa Fe for a one-night stay. **B, D**

DAY 6: Santa Fe - Albuquerque

Today we will enjoy a guided tour of the Santa Fe area. We will visit the Mission of San Miguel, one of our country's oldest churches. Priceless ornaments and paintings adorn the interior of this Mission. We will also see the Historic State Capitol Building of New Mexico which features many furnishings handcrafted by New Mexico natives. Continuing the guided city tour, we stop at The Loretto Chapel with its Miraculous Staircase, said to have been constructed by St. Joseph. Later today we arrive in the wonderful city of Albuquerque for a two-night stay. **B, D**

DAY 7: Albuquerque

On this morning's agenda we have a comprehensive two-hour city tour of Albuquerque including Sandia Peak, Rio Grande Valley, nostalgic Rt. 66 and Church of San Felipe de Neri-- with wonderful stained-glass and vivid retablos. The tour concludes in Old Town for free time and lunch on our own. While in Old Town, feel free to stroll the Plaza, dine at a variety of restaurants, or shop at over 150 stores and galleries for unique gifts from the Southwest and around the world. Quiet hidden patios, winding brick paths, gardens and balconies are waiting to be discovered in this fascinating village. The city tour will be followed by a stop at the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center where we will view exhibits featuring a brief historical overview of the Pueblo world including original artwork and craftsmanship. Tonight we will enjoy a special Farewell dinner atop Sandia Peak at the High Finance Restaurant. **B, D**
