ITINERARY

DAY 1: Gateway City - Providence, Rhode Island

This morning, fly to Providence, Rhode Island. After transferring to your hotel near Providence, enjoy a "Welcome Dinner." **D**

DAY 2: Providence - Newport - Hyannis, Massachusetts

Today enjoy a guided tour of Newport and its lovely mansions including a tour of the Breakers. Built in 1895, this seventy-two-room summer house of Cornelius Vanderbilt is probably Newport's most splendid mansion. Following lunch on your own, journey to Hyannis, Massachusetts. Enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers tonight on the first of your three-night stay. **CB, D**

DAY 3: Cape Cod - Provincetown Dunes

After breakfast, enjoy a guided sightseeing tour along Cape Cod where beaches and ponds remain in their natural state. Along the Cape, see weathered cottages, quaint villages and beautiful lighthouses. Sights also include the Cape Cod National Seashore, John F. Kennedy Memorial and Provincetown, where you have free time for lunch on your own. This afternoon take a tour of the historic sand dunes on

the Provincetown Cape Cod National Seashore. Discover dunes stretching as far as you can see with wispy beach grass, dark green pine trees and deep red beach plums nestled in hollows brought together by a silhouette of blue sky. Travel along the shoreline where your guide points out the “dune shacks” where famous artists and writers like Eugene O’Neill and Harry Kemp became inspired to create their art. **CB**

DAY 4: Nantucket Island

This morning travel to Nantucket Island which served as the center of the world’s whaling industry for more than 150 years. Nantucket has been named a National Historic District and has architecturally changed little since the 17th century, as seaside cottages and old-fashioned lamps still line its streets. At the harbor front where the great whaling ships set out on their hazardous journeys to return years later, if at all, pleasure boats now find safe harbor in one of the finest docking facilities in the world. Return to Hyannis this afternoon. Enjoy a delicious lobster dinner this evening. **CB, D**

DAY 5: Hyannis - Portland, Maine

This morning depart Hyannis for Portland, Maine. Enjoy lunch and shopping on your own at the Old Port District. This afternoon take a guided tour of Portland and learn little-known facts about the city that is nicknamed “The Phoenix.” Enjoy an included dinner this evening. Spend the night in South Portland. **CB, D**

DAY 6: Bar Harbor - Acadia National Park

After breakfast travel along the coast to Bar Harbor, Maine, once considered a small fishing and ship-building community. Enjoy free time and lunch on your own. This afternoon visit the first national park east of the Mississippi River, Acadia National Park. People have been drawn to the rugged coast of Maine throughout history. Awed by its beauty and diversity, early 20th-century visionaries donated the land that became Acadia National Park. The park is home to many plants and animals as well as the tallest mountain on the U.S. Atlantic coast. Dinner is included this evening. Overnight in Bar Harbor. **CB, D**

DAY 7: Freeport - L.L. Bean Outlet - Boston, Massachusetts

Depart Bar Harbor this morning for Freeport, Maine for a visit to the L. L. Bean Outlet. The store has a wide selection of apparel, gear, luggage and more all at discount prices and all carrying their legendary guarantee. After shopping and lunch on your own, travel to Boston area for a two-night stay. Enjoy dinner on the waterfront tonight. **B, D**

DAY 8: Whale Watch Cruise - Quincy Market - Boston City Tour

Then enjoy free time and lunch on your own at Quincy Market, a historic building near Faneuil Hall in downtown Boston. Constitution, Faneuil Hall, Harvard, Old North Church and Back Bay. **B**
