## ITINERARY

### Day 1: Gateway City - Deer Lake, Newfoundland

Depart your gateway city this morning for Newfoundland. Arrive at Deer Lake on the West Coast of Newfoundland and transfer to Corner Brook for a one-night stay. This evening we will enjoy a get together to meet your fellow travelers.

### Day 2: Gros Morne National Park - Port au Choix

This morning we will take the Viking Trail to beautiful Gros Morne National Park. We will travel along some of the most spectacular coastline in North America

and visit the National Historic Park at Port au Choix, which interprets the intriguing history and lifestyle of the Maritime Archaic people who lived here over 3,000 years ago. This evening, we will enjoy a "Welcome Dinner" on the first of a two-night stay in Plum Point. **B, L, D**

### Day 3: Sir Wilfred Grenfell's Home - L'Anse aux Meadows

Today we will travel the coastline to St. Anthony to visit the home of the famous medical missionary, Sir Wilfred Grenfell. The highlight of this day will be our visit to the UNESCO World Heritage site at L'Anse aux Meadows, home of Lief the Lucky and the Viking people who settled this area as early as the year 1,000 A.D. **B, L**

### Day 4: Straits of Belle Isle - Labrador

Keep a sharp eye out for whales as we travel across the Straits of Belle Isle to the shores of Labrador. Here, we will visit the recently discovered Whaling Station founded by the Basques in the early 1500s. Learn about the "modern techniques" used by these whalers and the hardships they endured. Later, we will visit the tallest lighthouse in the province at L'Anse Amour. We will spend the night in L'Anse au Clair. **B, L**

### Day 5: Newfoundland - The Arches

After breakfast, we will return to the island and





its UNESCO World Heritage status and its nickname as the “Galapagos of Plate Tectonics.” **B, L**

**Day 7: Grand Falls - Windsor - Gander**

We will leave the Viking Trail this morning and take a leisurely trip to the central Newfoundland logging town of Grand Falls-Windsor. Here, we will visit the Exploits River to watch the Atlantic Salmon make their way up one of the fishways on this massive river system. Then it is on to Lewisporte to visit the local craft shop and museum. Enjoy a “Mug Up” before traveling to Gander, the crossroads of the world, for the night. **B, L**

**Day 8: Twillingate Island - Newman Sound**

This morning we will be off on the “Road to the Isles” before traveling across “Tickles and Runs” to spend time on beautiful Twillingate Island. This is one of Newfoundland’s oldest and most interesting fishing communities. We will then travel to Terra Nova National Park to view the vistas of Newman Sound. This will be the first of two nights in Port Blandford/Clareville. **B, L**

**Day 9: Trinity - Cape Bonavista**

We will travel to the historic village of Trinity, one of the oldest communities in North America and the gem of the Island. Then it’s out to Cape Bonavista for a chance to walk the cliffs and enjoy the spectacular coastal scenery. Here, we will visit the Ryan Premises and learn about inshore fishing techniques that have allowed this town to thrive for hundreds of years. **B, L**

**Day 10: Bay Bulls - Witless Bay**

**Cape Spear National Historic Park - St. John’s**

Today, we will travel the Avalon Peninsula to the town of Bay Bulls. Then, we will take a boat trip to the Witless Bay Ecological Reserve where we will view thousands of Atlantic Puffins and other seabirds that nest here in the summer. Witless Bay is also home to many whales in the summer months, so sightings are a definite possibility. This afternoon, we will visit Cape Spear National Historic Park before heading into St. John’s, the capital of Newfoundland & Labrador, for a two-night stay. **B, L**

**Day 11: St. John’s - Cabot Tower on Signal Hill**

This morning, we will tour historic St. John’s, the oldest city in North America. This trip includes a visit to Cabot Tower and Signal Hill where we can view the famous “Narrows” and admire the local architecture. We will enjoy the afternoon at leisure. This evening we will share our “Farewell Dinner.” **B, D**

**Day 12: St. John’s - Gateway City**

Today we will fly home with wonderful memories of Newfoundland.
